

McDannald Fire

Preliminary burn severity analysis
Sentinel-2 images acquired
4/21/2018 and 5/16/2018

The McDannald fire burned 19,043 acres from April 30 to May 14 in Jeff Davis County. The fire was started by a lightning strike. It burned through a small portion of the Davis Mountains Preserve, but appears to have had minimal effects on restoration efforts for ponderosa pine.
